## What Is the Purpose of this Program?

The Advanced Academic Immersion (A<sup>2</sup>I) Summer Acceleration Program is designed to prepare students for entry into a rigorous course of study that affords ALL mathematics students the opportunity to accelerate their learning. A<sup>2</sup>I enables students to develop critical thinking and problem-solving skills essential to success in Advanced Placement (AP) and college courses.

## What is required to enter the program?

Be enrolled in high school for the Fall of 2024 (Spring 2024 students in grades 8 - 11 are eligible) Successful completion of pre-requisite courses

## What are the course requirements?

Attend the course for 100 hours (five hours a day for 20 days). No more than two absences are allowed. More
