Accountability Ratings

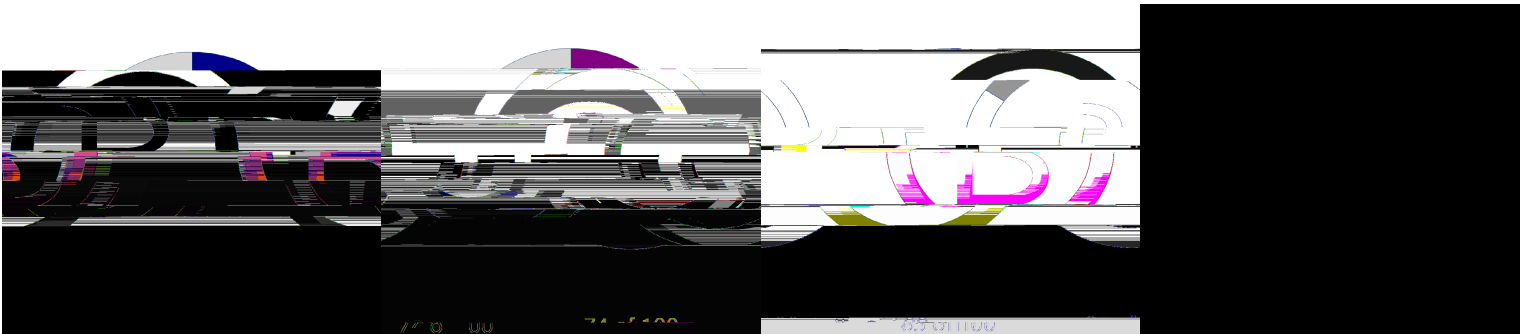
